ARVID MANFELD XV MEMORIAL AWARD COMPETITION IN BULLET SHOOTING

1. PURPOSE AND TASKS

- Establish a memorial to the former head of Liepāja PMK-16, Arvid Manfeld.
- Popularize and develop shooting sports in Dienvidkurzeme region and the country.
- Establish friendly relations with athletes from other regions and countries.

2. COMPETITION MANAGEMENT

The competition is organized and conducted by the Aizputes sports department of the Dienvidkurzeme region, Dienvidkurzeme sports school, and the Latvian Shooting Federation. The competition is supported by the entrepreneurs of Aizpute and the municipality of Dienvidkurzeme region.

3. TIME AND PLACE OF THE COMPETITION

The competition will take place in 2023 from October 6 to 8, in the hall of the Aizpute sports center (Ziedu street 7, Aizpute) and the Aizpute shooting range (Saules street 6a, Aizpute).

Entry of competition participants on October 6 from 17:00.

Start of the competition: October 7 at 9:00 a.m.;

October 8 at 8:00 a.m.

4. COMPETITION PARTICIPANTS

Dienvidkurzeme region and invited participants from Dobeles, Tukums, Rīga, Liepāja, Ādaži, Balvi (Viļaka), Ventspils, Kalnciems, Krāslava, as well as foreign guests from Lithuania (Šauli, Utenos, Vilnius, Kaunas, Klaipėda, Biržai) and Estonia (Elva, Haapsalu, Tartu, Ulenurme) take part in the competition. Athletes born before 2011 (inclusive) are invited to participate in the competition.

5. PROGRAM AND REGULATIONS

Competitions are held individually in rifle and pistol exercises.

6. EVALUATION

The results of the participants are evaluated individually according to the sum of points achieved in each exercise, separately for men and women.

Grading is taking place in the absolute test. In rifle exercises, PŠ-60 (basic exercise points) are counted together with MŠ-3x20. The winner of the absolute rating is determined by the total number of points.

In pistol exercises, scoring is done according to the same principle, adding PP-60 (basic exercise points) together with MP-30.

7. AWARD

The winners of the first three places in each exercise are awarded with diplomas and medals. If the new participants (born in 2004 and later) did not make it among the other participants of the competition, they receive diplomas for the first three places. The absolute winners for men and women receive the A. Manfelds memorial cup.
